    - Consensus that it would be better for BC to join as a co-op with an existing team like PC or Central Cambria

  - > Students, players and coaches are free
- 2017 Participation numbers (ideal is 15 to 25 per team)
  - ➤ Richland:
    - 20 plus in each grade
    - 5<sup>th</sup> grade may be between 15-20
  - Central Cambria
    - Light in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (currently 13)
    - Numbers are stable in all other grades (17-22 per grade)
  - ➤ McCort
    - Growing interest in starting flag for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade unknown numbers
    - Should be able to field teams in 4<sup>th</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade
  - ➤ Mainline (PC)
    - Strong overall numbers
    - 4th and 5th grade may be able to field 2 teams in each grade
    - Discussion to co-op or field 2 teams if needed to round out schedule for a grade due to lack of numbers in another organization

- > Westmont
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> should be good
  - No 4<sup>th</sup> grade team.
    - Some players may play up
    - Possibly cover with second PC team to round out schedule
  - 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades are strong
- > Forest Hills
  - Sign-ups (March 16<sup>th</sup>)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (20+)
  - 4<sup>th</sup> grade (20+)
  - 5th and 6th grades (14 to 15 each)
- Somerset
  - Sign-ups by end of April
  - Strong overall numbers. May also be able to support two teams in some grades
- Johnstown (Absent)
- Flag Football Discussion:
  - Inter-league play with 1st & 2nd grade
    - Currently Penn Cambria, Cambria Heights, Central Cambria play each other. Invites others to participate
    - Somerset has internal tackle for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
    - Other schools may consider joining
    - McCort has growing interest in starting flag program
  - Windber area actively recruiting teams and players
    - No interest to support or promote
